



Dick Darley Scholarship

2022 APPLICATION PROCESS and ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The Dick Darley Scholarship is a memorial scholarship in the amount of \$500 which may be awarded by the Juan de Fuca Football Club (JDFFC) each year to any applicant whose application is deemed to have met the eligibility criteria. The Scholarship will be payable to the winner(s) by cheque or electronic funds transfer upon receipt of proof of registration at a post-secondary training institution. A one-year deferral will be accepted upon written request.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

The candidate must:

- Be a current Grade 12 student
- Have played a minimum of three years for JDFFC
- Be dedicated to and have contributed (outside of game play) to JDFFC

Applications will be judged based on:

- Application presentation (spelling, grammar and completed application)
- A minimum C+ grade point average based on Grade 11 final marks and Grade 12 marks to date
- Demonstrated:
 - Sportsmanship
 - Leadership
 - Good Character
 - Game Sense
 - Dedication to team and club and
 - Current soccer activities

Each Candidate shall ensure that the application form and reference letters are type written and ensure that all required information, documentation and reference material is received no later May 31st, 2022. Candidate's letter may be hand written.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The following must accompany the completed application form:

- A letter of reference from a JDFFC Coach who either coaches or has coached the candidate
- A transcript of the candidate's Grade 11 final marks and an official document from the candidate's school showing their Grade 12 marks to date (e.g. letter from school, report card, etc.)
- A letter of reference from a Teacher who is teaching or has taught the candidate
- A letter from the candidate as outlined on the Application Form

2022 Scholarship – Consideration related to COVID-19:

All applications and supporting materials including reference letters **must be received** by JDFFC **no later than May 31st, 2022** to be considered by the Committee. All material should be sent via email to scholarship@jdfsoccer.ca. Letters of reference, transcripts and official documents can be sent directly to scholarship@jdfsoccer.ca. It is the candidate's responsibility to ensure their application is complete and that JDFFC receives all items as noted in Application Requirements above by the May 31st, 2022 deadline.

SELECTION PROCESS

The Scholarship Committee must consist of three (3) members: at least one member of the JDFFC Board of Directors (who shall act as the Scholarship Committee chairperson), one educational representative (Teacher or Professor) and one other person.

Committee members must be neutral and therefore must have no association with any of the candidates as a parent, immediate family member, coach or teacher.

When the chairperson receives the application they shall ensure that the other committee members receive full copies of the applications for review prior to the committee meeting. There shall be a meeting of the scholarship committee as a whole prior to making any recommendation(s). If committee members are unanimous in their individual recommendation(s), the committee members can agree to forego a committee meeting. Any meeting can be hosted virtually.

The recommendation(s) of the JDFFC Scholarship Committee must be presented to the JDFFC Board of Directors prior to the awarding of any scholarship(s).

The decision of JDFFC Board of Directors is final in the matter of this award.


